Basic Fetal Monitoring

Course Description

This course provides information that will assist the beginning practitioner in providing safe and quality care for the mother and baby.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this program the participant will be able to:

1. Identify methods and indications for fetal heart monitoring (FHM)
2. Identify basic physiological reasons for fetal heart rate patterns
3. Analyze fetal monitoring case studies for reassuring and non-reassuring data
4. Utilize critical thinking skills to identify nursing interventions related to FHM and evaluate maternal-fetal responses
5. Participate in critical thinking exercises that utilize written documentation and verbal communication skills.

Course Description

Advanced Fetal Monitoring

This course provides information that will assist the experienced practitioner in providing safe and quality care for the mother and baby.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this program the participant will be able to:

1. Describe the nursing process related to fetal monitoring
2. Evaluate fetal and maternal patterns determining oxygenation status of fetus and underlying physiological response.
3. Recognize clinical indicators of impending acidemia
4. Analyze fetal monitoring case studies to identify accelerations, decelerations and mixed patterns
5. Describe recommended interventions using NICHD standardized terminology
6. Evaluate uterine and fetal response to intrapartum use of Pitocin.
7. Describe hazards, warning signs and individual response to use of Pitocin
8. List antepartum and intrapartum risk using a variety of clinical assessment tools.
9. Describe an appropriate documentation process utilizing NICHD terminology.
10. Utilize appropriate communication skills to relate assessment, interventions and maternal fetal response

S.T.A.B.L.E. Course

Course Description

The intent of this course is to provide critical guidelines to stabilize the sick neonate.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this program the participant will be able to:

1. Identify neonates at risk for developing hypoglycemia
2. List symptoms and treatment modalities of hypoglycemia
3. Identify the detrimental effects of hypothermia
4. Discuss the process of warming and monitoring severely hypothermic infants
5. Describe the evaluation of and causes of neonatal respiratory distress
6. Interpret blood gases using the acid/base alignment nomogram system
7. Discuss treatment of neonatal respiratory distress
8. Describe causes, presentation and initial treatment of hypovolemic, cardiogenic and septic shock
9. Correlate symptoms with lab work results
10. Discuss the crisis that families face when infants require transport to a neonatal ICU
11. Identify ways caregivers can support families of sick newborns
